Creative Arts Center Hosts 2016 Blue Plate Special to Celebrate 50th Anniversary on April 30th

Signature Fundraising Event Auctions Exclusive Plates Designed by Notable Texas Artists

Dallas, TX (April 2016) – Celebrating its 50th anniversary, the Creative Arts Center of Dallas (CAC) is hosting its signature fundraising event, the Blue Plate Special, on Saturday, April 30th with Honorary Co-Chairs Patricia B. Meadows and Gail Sachson. The popular fundraiser features a silent auction of ceramic plates designed by notable local artists as well as CAC instructors and students. Funds raised from the Blue Plate Special support the Center's mission and outreach programming. The celebratory evening will feature cocktails, dining, live entertainment and a chance for guests to bid on one-of-a-kind plates and platters which are paired with other silent auction donations, such as tickets to artistic events, restaurant gift certificates, hotel stays and other fantastic items. This year's event will be held at 7 for Parties on Turtle Creek Drive in the Dallas Design District from 7p.m. – 10:30p.m. The 2016 Blue Plate Special is chaired by board members Todd C. Hedrick and Nancy Woolfolk, with Lynn Armstrong serving as a support chair.

Driven by the belief that artistic development strengthens communities, Creative Arts Center nurtures a community where people of all ages discover and develop their artistic vision through arts education and transformational outreach. This vital mission is generously funded year-round through donor and member support, as well as CAC's signature fundraiser, the Blue Plate Special. The event was popular more than 10 years ago but did not continue as there was no staff then to support an event on this scale. "Artists and CAC supporters continually asked us to bring the event back so we did in 2014," says event chair and CAC board member Todd C. Hedrick. "Dozens of notable Texas artists have lent their time and talents to create original plates up for auction this year including Bernaba Fitzgerald, Pamela Nelson and Brad Oldham.
